



Mission Route & Day-to-Day Programme

Mount Kilimanjaro is the highest mountain in Africa at an altitude of 5895 meters. Uhuru (which means **Freedom**) peak -and the missions destination-constitutes the ultimate goal of many climbers from around the world.

Kilimanjaro is the only mountain in Africa, covered in glaciers, but because of global warming they are now melting and they will continue to in the next decades.

There are six main routes that lead to the mountain's peak. **Machame** is considered to be the most beautiful and the longest one. This route has also the highest success rates, because of the altitude, which helps for a better acclimatization. That is the reason we have chosen this route to introduce to you the magnificent beauty of this area, with the most amazingly unique fauna and flora.





Mission Route & Day-to-Day Programme



DAY 1 - Monday . 2 August

Arrival at Kilimanjaro International Airport and transfer to **Moshi village**. Dinner and preparations for the next day. Rest at the hotel for the night.

DAY 2 - Tuesday . 3 August

Breakfast and departure from Moshi, towards **Machame gate** (1810m). Once finished with the necessary procedures and paperwork at the gate, we continue trekking through the tropical woods up to **Machame Camp** at 3020m, where we enjoy our dinner and camp for the night.

Distance: 10,5km **Altitude difference:** 1210m **Duration:** 7hrs

DAY 3 - Wednesday . 4 August

Trekking to **Shira Hut** at 3840m. Break for lunch and dinner at the campsite.

Distance: 5,5km **Altitude difference:** 820m **Duration:** 8hrs

DAY 4 - Thursday . 5 August

Tower (4627m) to aid better acclimatization. Descent to Barranco (3990m) to enjoy our dinner and rest for the night.

Distance: 10,5km **Altitude difference:** 150m **Duration:** 7hrs

DAY 5 - Friday . 6 August

Departure for **Karanga** (4030m). We will attempt to climb **Barranco Wall** for 40' and then descent to Karanga valley for dinner and rest for the night.

Distance: 5km **Altitude difference:** 40m **Duration:** 7 hours

DAY 6 - Saturday . 7 August

Departure for our last campsite at **Barafu Hut** (4660m). Lunch and rest in the afternoon to prepare for our ascent.

Distance: 5km **Altitude difference:** 630m **Duration:** 4hrs

DAY 7 - Sunday . 8 August

We wake up at 23:00, for tea and biscuits and prepare to climb **Uhuru peak** (5895m) through **Stella Point** (5745m), just in time for sunrise. Picture taking at the peak and continue for our descent back to Barafu for breakfast. Descent to **Mweka Hut** for the night.

Distance: 15km Altitude difference: 1230m

Duration: 10hrs

DAY 8 - Monday . 9 August

We descent through the tropical woods, towards **gate Mweka**. Our guides will sing a traditional song called the **Kili Song** to celebrate our big success! There, we are awarded a certificate confirming our climbing success. Continue to **Arusha** to rest and celebrate!

Dinner and overnight stay at the hotel before the flight home...

Team departs to Tanzania on 1st August, initiates its mission on 3rd August, and summit the Uhuru Peak (5895m) on 9th August.


Principles of the team and the campaign:




